It does not teach Camera fundamentals and will not show anyone how to turn on their camera, but does deal with the mysteries of the esoteric values of imagery like light and shadow, via simple and easily understood explanations. Through example, we step through the fundamentals of:

Light/Shadow

Composition

Exposure

Subject

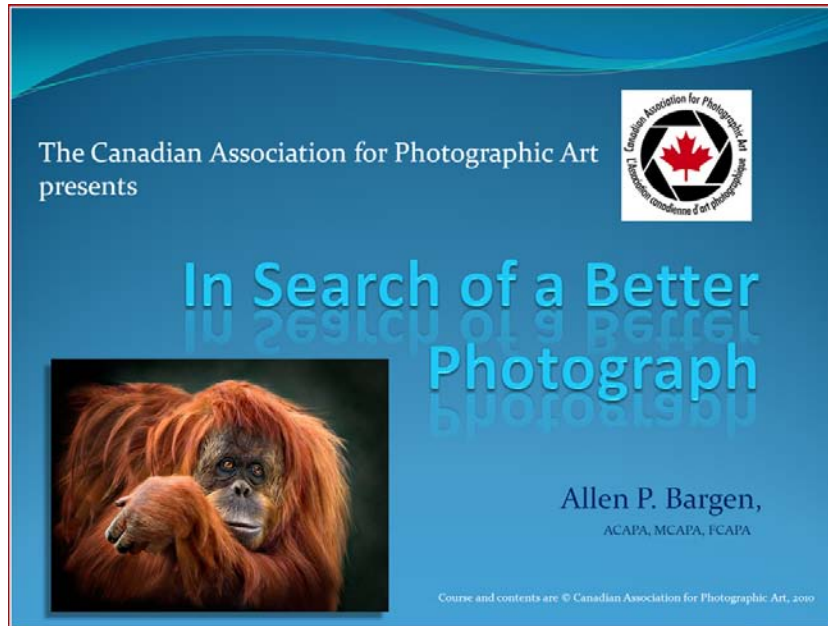
Story

Colour

Contrast

Sharpness

Depth of field



By means of numerous visual examples, definition, and discussion on the fundamentals, we deliver the message. The course talks about things like why you should take more than one image, with different exposures, with examples of what that can do to a photograph, and so on.
