

## SaskAm 2010 Rules:

1. This competition is open to **amateur** photographers who are Saskatchewan residents. **Anyone who is making \$15 000.00 annually from photography or who is a regular member of or pays dues to a professional photography association does not qualify as amateur and therefore cannot enter this competition.**
2. All images entered must be taken in Saskatchewan; the only exception is in the "Travel" category.
3. All images must be prints, no smaller than 80 (ie.8x10) square inches and no larger than 320 (ie. 16x20) square inches.
4. All images **must** be mounted on a matt board or foam core backing with a maximum finished size of the final product to be no more than 320 square inches. Glass and framing **will not** be accepted. Matting is accepted but not required.
5. All entries must be the work of the entrant including any photo editing. Printing may be done at any commercial or private printer.
6. Name, address, phone number, e-mail address, title of image, and category must appear on the back in the TOP RIGHT hand corner for proper identification and orientation. Entries with any identifying marks on the front will not be accepted.
7. Digital "touch-ups" and/or "retouching" are allowed in all categories. As defined as the image represents the reality of what we see in everyday life.
8. Photos edited and manipulated beyond a representation of reality are only eligible for entry in the "WOW" category, where any amount of photo editing and manipulation is encouraged.
9. Previous award winning SaskAm images are not allowed to be entered again. No image can be entered in more than one category.
10. Entries will be judged in category entered.
11. The decisions of the judges and the SaskAm committee are final. The SaskAm committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries displayed as space permits and on content of the image.
12. All entries will be handled with care; however SaskAm and all its affiliates will not assume responsibility for loss or damage of entries.
13. Completed and signed entry forms with entry fees, postage and handling fees, if applicable, must accompany all entries. A digital copy may accompany your entries but must be available before any prizes are awarded
14. The rights of all images remain with the photographer but the SaskAm photo competition and its affiliates may use any image entered for promotional materials and display with a photo credit awarded to the photographer.
15. Entries not meeting the rules will not be accepted.
